

Parking & SUMP

Key objectives:

- Uplift Parking management from an operational task to a strategical one
- Use innovative parking management as a backbone of the SUMP
- ParkPAD : raise awareness and develop an action plan in a co-creation process by including all relevant players from the beginning







Main Activities realised (project level)



- **22 national trainings** (+ cross project/ institutional cooperation)
- **ParkPAD** tested and ready for exploitation Autumn 2022 (BP)
- **CDE strategy** roll out : various activities at local, national & international level (CIVITAS, Eltis, EPA, Polis, ...) incl. materials (websites, video's, brochures, social media, ...)
- Working on high level 'policy recommendations' with a focus on 'parking standards' and 'EV charging and parking' (workshops)
- Impact counterproductive national legislations
- COVID Impact assessment and contingency plan
- New SUMP 2.0 Topic Guide on Parking and SUMP integration (Sept 22)



Targeted impact



16 Park4SUMP cities have:

integrated parking management into their (future) SUMP
reclaimed 10 % public space across city area (-2000 on-street parking)
dedicated at least 10 % of parking revenue to sustainable mobility uses
implemented 76 good practice parking management measures

>50 external follower cities

- will benefit from capacity building and exploitation of results to improve integration of parking & SUMP policies,
- implementing +300 measures
